What are the participation requirements?

10 - 12 years old. Each child will be screened prior to admittance into our program to determine appropriateness of and readiness for enrollment. The screening is \$60.00.

With this said, there may be circumstances where members of the group cannot attend; this will not result in cancellation of group. The therapist, instead, will provide intensive one-on-one instruction to the group member to introduce the week's topic. While we ideally want all members of the group in attendance, we are skilled in adapting the therapy process to best meet the needs of the child(ren) participating any given session.
